Moonlighting Criteria

- Passed USMLE step 3/COMLEX level 3
- Residents who have completed 24 months of training
- US citizens, US residents, people with "Asylum" status, and J2 visa holders
- J1 and H1 visa holders are currently not allowed to moonlight.

Moonlighting Criteria Cont.

- If resident has scored at least 60% score on the fall 2021 AND spring 2022 ITE:
 - Ok to moonlight for the entire year
 - If there is a drastic decrease in fall 2022 ITE performance, will need to meet with Dr. K to discuss
- If resident has scored < 60% on the fall 2021 OR spring 2022 mock ITE:
 - Ok to start the process and to moonlight, but they must score at least 60% on the fall 2022 ITE to maintain moonlighting privileges
- If resident has scored < 60% on the fall 2021 AND spring 2022 mock ITE
 - Can retake the ITE now or wait until the fall 2022 ITE.
 - Must score at least 60% on the both ITE's to start the process AND maintain moonlighting privileges
